



## Dyslexia Brain Study

**Adult readers with Dyslexia** are needed for a brain-imaging study at the University of Washington. We want to gather information about how brains of readers with dyslexia integrate sight with sound. We are looking for **right-handed adults from 18 - 45 years of age, with no metal in their body or on their body** that cannot be removed. The study will involve up to three visits to collect brain data using **magnetoencephalography (MEG), electroencephalography (EEG), and magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) technology.**
