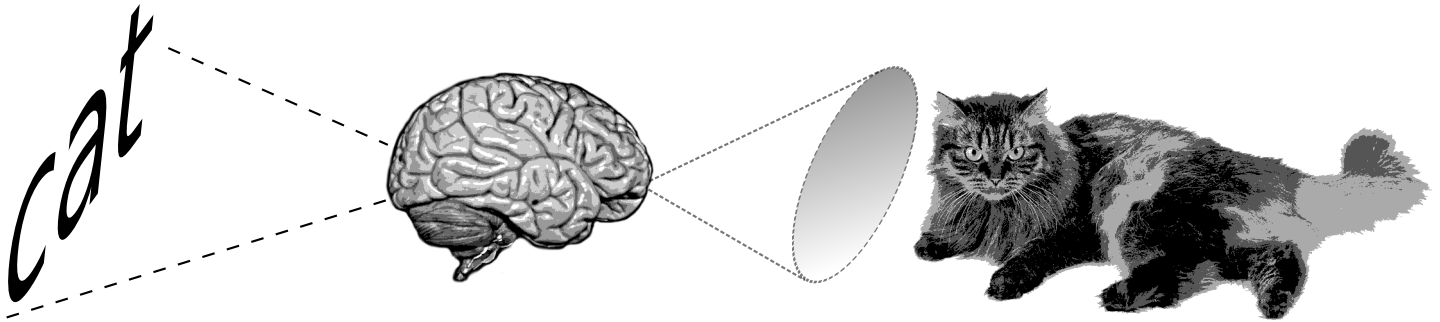


# Brain and Reading Development Study
